

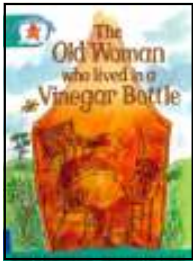
Reading Schemes for Individual Reading Progression

*In order to give our children a depth of reading experience, we have a range of progressive reading schemes that we use throughout our school.

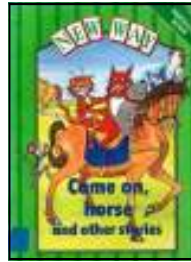
*We follow a suggested order of progression but groups of books may be added or skipped depending on a child's individual progress. We find that children can respond very differently to different books and schemes.

***As always, our door is always open to if you want to come in and discuss any aspect of your child's reading with us.**



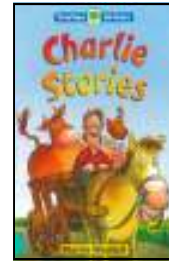

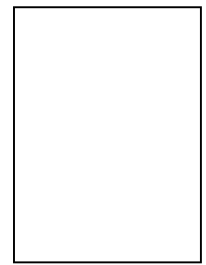

Reading Schemes for Guided Reading

For children in Reception, Year 1 and for some older children we use phonetically decodable books during guided reading sessions. The children get the chance to consolidate their sounding out skills whilst answering questions about a text.

Children working at high level 2 up to level 5 use a range of books that aren't necessarily from a scheme.
