School Closure due to bad weather

In the last couple of years, we have extensively reviewed our 'extreme weather' procedures and stress to all our families that I will always make every effort to open school in cases of bad weather but only if I can guarantee it is safe to do so. "Safe" is not always referring to the ground conditions and often refers to the ratio of adults and children I can offer. I would ask for everyone's understanding that there MAY be instances when the weather conditions around school do not seem severe at all but, as many staff travel long distances to Edgworth, I may be unable to safely open school due to the number of staff who can make it in. The procedure for informing families remains the same in that, only if the school is to be closed or delayed start, we will send a text message and email to all parents, staff, governors and external agencies at 7am and a note will be added to the school website to advise of the plans for the day. Please do not use any other form of communication (e.g. Facebook) or hearsay as a basis for a decision about school opening as this has led to confusion in the past.

It is possible that in extreme weather we may have a delayed start, but this would be communicated in the official 7am message. If the weather takes an extreme turn for the worse during the day, we will contact all parents to arrange collection of children. Children will not be released unless we have made contact with parents.

Please ensure the number we have as your emergency contact is one that can be reached during the day. On occasion, we have tried to ring an emergency number only to find it is to a phone that must be switched off during the working day and so, as such, is not an appropriate emergency contact number. Thank you in advance of your support on this challenging issue.

Christmas Lunch

Christmas Lunch & Hat Competition – Wednesday 6th December (No tuck shop on this day)

As is tradition, Mrs Appleton and her team of elves will be serving Christmas lunch to the children on Wednesday 6th December. All children who are already on school meals will automatically be offered this lunch (vegetarian/vegan options available too). However, if your child is currently on packed lunches from home, but wishes to join in, please email the school office to reserve their place before 30th November. Unfortunately, late bookings cannot be accepted as Mrs Appleton will need to place her orders in advance. The cost of the lunch is £2.60 which will be added to your child's ParentPay account. Mrs Appleton is also running her Christmas hat competition which is open to all children and prizes will go to those children judged to have put lots of effort into their own creation! Hats can be brought into school on Wed 6th Dec for judging.

Christmas Carol Service (KS2)

We are once again going to be having our school Christmas Carol Service at St. Anne's Church in Chapeltown on Thursday 14th December starting at 1.45pm. Only children in Years 3 to 6 will be walking to Church, however, all families are welcome to attend. Each junior class will be singing their favourite Carol.

Children will walk to and from the church so please ensure they have a coat. Children should wear their school uniform and they may wear a Christmas hat, reindeer headband, tinsel in their hair, etc. The service should last around 30 minutes and we will then be selling hot chocolate and mince pies for £1.
